Responsibilities will include: administrative leadership of the clinical neuropathology section to College of American Pathologists accreditation standards, sign-out service in neuropathology (including intraoperative consultation- call) and autopsy service. There is no requirement for participation in general surgical pathology sign out.

The ideal candidate will have a demonstrated interest in teaching and mentoring residents, support staff, medical students and graduate students. There is an expectation of scholarly activity including collaborative research and publications but the candidate will not be expected to submit grants for extramural funding. Participation in quality improvement initiatives is available and encouraged. Academic rank will depend on the credentials of the applicant.
