## The American Association of Neuropathologists 96<sup>th</sup> Annual Meeting

This is an update regarding the 96<sup>th</sup> Annual Meeting as related to the coronavirus (COVID-19). The American Association of Neuropathologists (AANP) takes this pandemic very seriously and is continuing to monitor developments of this virus in order to be prepared for the challenges it may pose to the 96<sup>th</sup> Annual Meeting. We are giving highest priority to the health, safety and well-being of the membership. At this time, it is not clear what the landscape will look like in mid-June; as such we are **not** cancelling the 96<sup>th</sup> Annual Meeting scheduled for June 11-14, at this point.

Many of the current travel bans implemented by institutions extend until late April, with ongoing monitoring. The AANP will continue to monitor developments related to COVID-19, including any government regulations and/or recommendations related to holding large conferences.
