Diagnostic Slide Session

The Diagnostic Slide Session (DSS) will take place on Saturday evening, June 9th, 2018, at the 94th Annual Meeting. This year, there will be 12 cases presented, including a wide spectrum of neuromuscular, neurodegenerative, neoplastic and very unusual disorders! Whole slide images of the cases will be placed on the DSS website in early May, scanned at x40, to be viewed at zero cost.

Abstract Submissions

The deadline to submit abstracts for the 94th Annual Meeting has passed, and the Program Committee has worked tirelessly to review each submission. This year there were 218 abstracts submitted. There will be 64 platform presentations and 154 poster presentations at the 94th Annual Meeting, all featuring original research. Once the Program Committee finalizes the format of each abstract, platform or poster, the presenting authors will be contacted.

This year the AANP is pleased to provide additional Travel Awards. In addition to the six (6) \$1,000 Trainee Travel Awards presented annually, there will also be four (4) ISN Travel Awards and twenty (20) \$500 Trainee Travel Awards presented at the 94th Annual Meeting. The Program Committee selects travel award recipients who will be notified by May 15, 2018.
