This position will involve diagnostic surgical neuropathology, autopsy neuropathology and ophthalmologic pathology; depending on candidate preference/training, additional sign out opportunities in a sub-specialized surgical pathology service or autopsy are also available. The successful candidate will be eligible for membership in the UNC Lineberger Comprehensive Cancer Center and will contribute to the teaching of residents, fellows, medical students, and graduate students. Applicants must have an MD degree, be board-certified or board eligible in Anatomic Pathology and Neuropathology, and be eligible to obtain a medical license in North Carolina.
