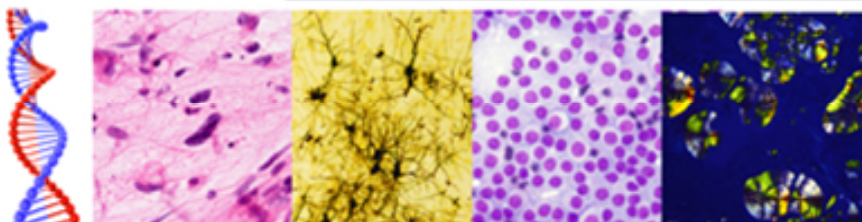

ACCME and Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada (RCPSC) Collaboration

The ACCME and the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada (RCPSC) have collaborated to enable Royal College Fellows to earn Section 3 credits by participating in accredited CME that counts for MOC. Royal College Fellows will be able to report participation in accredited CME activities that are available on or after November 1, 2019." [Click here to read more](#). What this means: Since AANP self-assessment modules are registered for MOC in accordance with American Board of Pathology requirements, Royal College Fellows may earn Section 3 credits by participating in AANP SAMs. Royal College Fellows are responsible for reporting their participation to the Royal College.

Accessing the JNEN via the AANP Members-Only Area:

To access the *JNEN* from the members-only area of the AANP website follow these steps:

1. [Log-in](#) to your MemberClicks profile using the "Member Login" in the top right corner of the AANP Homepage.
2. Once logged-in click "My AANP" from the blue menu bar on the far right.
3. Under your nametag, on the right, select "Access *JNEN*". You will be taken directly to the *JNEN* webpage with access to all content.

Please Note: If you do not access the *JNEN* via the AANP members-only area of the website you will need to log-in via the Oxford University Press website using your credentials specific to that account.

Please be advised that, going forward, "Brief Reports" will no longer be accepted in their previous format (see below for details). Please see the *Journal of Neuropathology & Experimental Neurology* [Instructions to Authors](#) for further information on how your manuscript should be submitted.

Letters to the Editor/Brief Reports

Brief manuscripts (e.g. a report of a single novel or unique case) should be submitted as a Letter to the Editor with an upper limit of five double-spaced text pages. The letter should not include distinct sections such as an Abstract, Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results or Discussion. Figures, tables, and references, if included, must fit within these constraints. Only reports deemed to be of high scientific value and potential widespread interest to the JNEN readership will be considered for publication. Letters may also be submitted to comment on articles published in the Journal or on specific aspects of neuropathology following these guidelines.

When submitted in the appropriate format, a brief report which offers new insight will be considered for publication as a Letter to the Editor.
